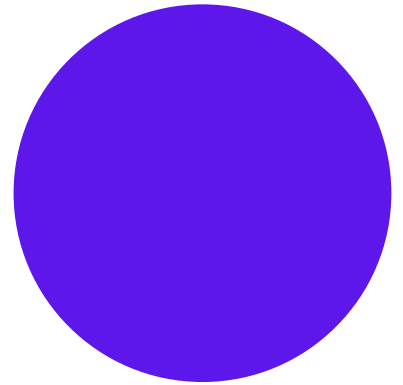
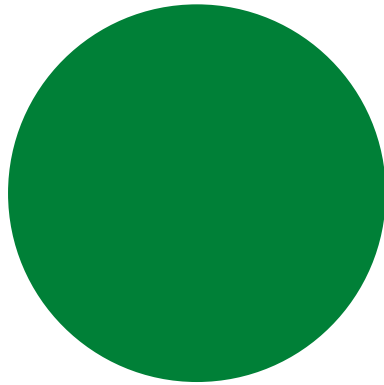
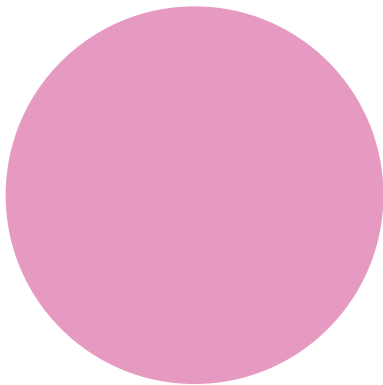


COURSES IN ITALIAN LANGUAGE & CULTURE

You can produce simple connected text on familiar topics. You can describe experiences, events, dreams, hopes, and ambitions and explain opinions and plans.</p>	<p>C1</p> <p>You can understand a wide range of demanding texts and recognize implicit meaning. You can express yourself fluently and spontaneously, using language effectively for social, academic and professional purposes. You can produce clear, well-structured, detailed texts on complex subjects.</p>
<p>A2</p> <p>You can understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to topics such as personal and family information, shopping, and local geography. You can exchange information simply and directly on familiar and routine matters.</p>	<p>B2</p> <p>You can follow the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in your field of specialisation. You can interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity with a native speaker. You can produce clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain various viewpoints on topical issues.</p>	<p>C2</p> <p>You can easily understand virtually everything heard or read. You can summarise information from different spoken and written sources, reconstructing arguments and accounts in a coherent presentation. You can express yourself very fluently and precisely, differentiating finer shades of meaning even in more complex situations.</p>
